

BUDGET MEETING



The workshop was called to order at 8:38 AM by Chairman Richard Beal. Preliminary figures for the 2010 budget were discussed. Bill McGuinness joins us today to discuss a warrant article for Islesford Neighborhood House Association (INHA). The INHA wishes to ask the voters to allow the installation of a subsurface sewage disposal field and performance of any attendant roadwork necessary to link the system, on town owned land at the Islesford Town Field, said system to be constructed by and entirely at the expense of the INHA. The Board of Selectmen wishes to add a statement to the article, giving full indemnification to the INHA for bringing the roads and Town Field back to the same or better condition as before the work was done.
