

COVID -19 Health Emergency

Effective March 17 to April 1

A Public Health Emergency has been declared in the Town of Cranberry Isles with the following directive from the Cranberry Isles Board of Selectmen:

Contractors commuting daily to Cranberry Isles for work must remain on their jobsites while on island for work and maintain proper social distance from residents at all times, including limiting interactions with island residents. Year-round residents who are returning from trips, as well as returning summer residents, are required to self-quarantine for two weeks and be fever-free for at least three days. All residents and visitors are advised to follow current US Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommendations for limiting public gatherings and observing proper social distance. Unnecessary off island travel is strongly discouraged for island residents

Cari Alley, Health Officer for the Town of Cranberry Isles has advised that she will be providing public information and assistance by a variety of means as the situation warrants and as she is authorized as the Local Health Officer.

These rules and guidelines are in effect **March 17 to April 1**

A follow-up meeting of the Board of Selectmen will be held on Friday, March 20, 2020 at 10am at the Town Office to further assess the situation as it evolves.
