The truck has a 750-gpm Darley pump. The truck has some mechanical issues, including but not limited to: rear main seal leak, oil pan seal leak, right front axel seal leak and leaking differentials. The vehicle has been stored inside a heated garage since 2001, when it was purchased from Walter Apparatus, Inc. in Colorado by the Great Cranberry Island VFD.
