The truck was in service for the Great Cranberry Island Volunteer Fire Department until mid August 2020. It has 500 gallons of on board water and a 250 gallon auxiliary tank. The truck has a 750-gpm Darley pump. The truck has some mechanical issues, including but not limited to: rear main seal leak, oil pan seal leak, right front axle seal leak and leaking differentials. The vehicle has been stored inside a heated garage since 2001, when it was purchased from Walter Apparatus, Inc. in Colorado by the Great Cranberry Island VFD.
