

1st Annual Cranberry Isles Fire & Rescue Auxiliary Fishing Tournament Rules

1.The Tournament will take place from Monday, July 26, 2021, to Friday, August 6, 2021.

2. Entries must be placed by 8 pm on Friday, August 6, 2021.

3. Winners will be announced the morning of Saturday, August 7, 2021.

4. Anglers may register before or anytime during the tournament by contacting Katelyn Damon at

5. Entry fees are non-refundable and will be considered a donation to the Cranberry Isles Fire & Rescue Auxiliary.

6. Boundaries of the tournament will be Cranberry Isles waters which are defined in the Harbor Management Ordinance as any water within 1/3 a mile from any of the Cranberry Isles' five islands.

7. Eligible species of fish are mackerel, herring, pollack, cod, striped bass, bluefish, cusk, haddock, black sea bass, and redfish.

8. All fishing and angling methods must comply with current Federal, State, and U.S.C.G. Safety and Fishing Regulations including registering with the Maine Saltwater Recreational Fishing Registry.

9. Fish must be caught by hook and line, handheld rods and reels only.

10. Eligible fish may be caught on land, boat, float, or kayak.

 The tournament will be judged on photos of the catch.
 Each angler will submit a photo demonstrating the measurement of their largest catch. Submit a photo by text (207) 479-8118 or email to katelyn@cranberryisles-me.gov.

12. Only photos with a clearly visible whole fish of the designated tournament species, and clearly visible measurement will be accepted for the tournament.

13. Pictures must be taken with the nose of fish, facing left, flush with the tournament rule stick with closed mouth and pinched tail. The picture needs to include the entire fish and clearly show the overall length.

14. The Cranberry Isles Fire & Rescue Fishing Tournament will provide an official rule stick for use during the duration of the tournament. Supplies are limited.

15. Each angler will be responsible for creating a card to photograph with their entries. The card will clearly display the angler's first initial and last name to help keep entries organized throughout the tournament.

16. Anglers are responsible for providing their own digital photo equipment. The tournament committee will not be providing any equipment or technical support. All photos turned in for judgment will become the property of the tournament.

17. The Honor System will apply throughout the duration of the entire tournament. Anyone deemed to have broken these rules will be

banned from fishing in any future tournaments.

18. It is up to the discretion of the registered angler to determine whether his or her craft is seaworthy for existing sea conditions. Participants are encouraged to remain aware of any marine or weather warnings. The tournament is not responsible for the safety of participating anglers.

19. The Cranberry Isles Fire & Rescue Fishing Tournament encourages the live release of all fish not intended to be eaten.

20. The Cranberry Isles Fire & Rescue Auxiliary Board will serve as the tournament committee should there be any ties or disputes. All decisions of the board are final.
