JUNK CAR REMOVAL

The Town is arranging for John Goodwin, Jr. Company to assist in removing junk vehicles from Great Cranberry and Islesford. The Town will pay for barging costs, with no additional cost/fee for removal and transport to a junk yard paid by vehicle owners to the Town or John Goodwin Co.

If you have a junk vehicle that you need to have taken off the island, please contact the Cranberry Isles Town Office (207) 244-4475; phone calls during business hours (9am – 3pm Monday-Friday), works best, or leave a voicemail. We will compile a list of vehicles (including - make/model/year) and the owners at the Town Office. **A Title will need to be provided for any vehicle 2000 or newer.** The limit of the number of vehicles that can be barged will initially be limited to 12 per island. The list will be compiled on a first-come/first-served basis and will be limited to one vehicle per household. We will still include you on a waiting list once our limit is reached. Once we have a full list we can see if more cars can be fit in based on our budget for junk car removal.

The collection points will be the Town gravel pits on GCI and LCI. Once we have added you to the list you can take the vehicle to the gravel pit. Make your request to be added to the list at the Town Office no later than Monday, September 14. The Town will arrange the barging dates with John Goodwin Jr. Company once we have compiled the list and know the number of vehicles.
